Mr. Onesimus Asimwe has served as the first lay Chaplain (Personal Assistant) to the Archbishop in the history of the Church of Uganda, the Most Rev. Henry Luke Orombi since 2006. Prior to becoming the Archbishop's Chaplain, he served as the Director of the Church of Uganda's Ministry of Healing, Deliverance and Intercessory Prayer. Immediately after university, he taught Fine Art at Kabale High School in Western Uganda, as well as serving as the Patron for the school's chapter of Scripture Union. He has also served as a lay evangelist, preaching not only in Uganda, but also in the United States and the UK. He received his Bachelor of Education (Fine Arts degree) from Makerere University, Kampala, in 1995. He is married to Florence and they have three children: David, Ruth, and Marjorie. Onesimus also serves on the Board of Directors for the King's Daughters Ministry, a ministry focused on healing and holistic care for former street girls in Kampala.
